Instructions for Estate/Trust Estimated Tax Payment Form

See payment form on page 2

Estimated tax is not required for estates or trusts. However, these forms are provided for those who prefer filing estimated tax. These forms should not be used to remit payment on behalf of individual beneficiaries of the estate or trust, use the form DR 0104BEP to remit payment on behalf of individual beneficiaries of the estate or trust.

Calculating the Payment

Estimated tax payments can be made on a quarterly basis. When making payments, be sure to use the same account numbers that are used when filing the annual 105 return. It is strongly recommended that these payments be remitted electronically to avoid problems and delays. The single form can be copied and used for each of the four quarterly payments if an electronic payment cannot be made for any reason.

Penalties

There is no penalty for failure to file estimated tax for estates or trusts.

Go Green with Revenue Online

Colorado.gov/RevenueOnline allows taxpayers to file taxes, make payments and monitor their accounts. The DR 0105EP is not required to be sent if electronic payment is remitted through this site. Please be advised that a nominal processing fee may apply to online payments.

Pay by Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT)

EFT payments can be made safely, for free, and can be scheduled up to 12 months ahead of time to avoid forgetting to make a payment. This requires pre-registration before payments can be made. Visit Colorado.gov/revenue/eft for registration information.

Return the DR 0105EP with check or money order payable to the "Colorado Department of Revenue". Mail payments to Colorado Department of Revenue, Denver, Colorado 80261-0008. These addresses and zip codes are exclusive to the Colorado Department of Revenue, so a street address is not required. Write your Colorado Account Number or FEIN and "2020 DR 0105EP" on your check or money order. Do not send cash. Enclose, but do not staple or attach, your payment with this form. File only if you are making a payment of estimated tax.
