## 2018 Statement of Colorado Tax Remittance for Nonresident Partner, Shareholder or Member

In general, partnerships should remit withholding for their nonresident partners. However, if a composite return is filed to include such nonresident partner/shareholder the withholding is not required. Nonresident partner withholding is due on the 15th day of the fourth month following the end of the taxable year. DO NOT file a DR 0108 for Nonresident partners, shareholders or members with a \$0 withholding liability.

<u>Please note</u>, a **MAXIMUM** of fifty (50) DR 0108 forms may be submitted with a single payment. DR 0108 totals must exactly match the payments, or the Department **WILL NOT** transfer the funds on behalf of the partnership. **DO NOT** remit payment via EFT.
